Chick Corea's four-decade career is the stuff of jazz lore - his groups are hotbeds of imagination, seething with the joy of making music while creating influential, limit-stretching musical experiences. Of course, the same could be said of fellow Miles Davis alum Jack DeJohnette, and of Bobby McFerrin, one of the natural wonders of the music world whose work encompasses both classical and jazz through vocal performance, conducting, and composition. This sensational trio comes together for the first time for what promises to be an unforgettable night of jazz.

On April 25 and 26 we will travel to Indianapolis, IN to take in a concert of 3 jazz greats at Clowes Memorial Hall on Butler University Campus. We will stay Friday night, participate in a choir clinic on Saturday morning, eat at Circle Center Mall, and have other fun activities in the afternoon. We will return to Lexington on Saturday evening.

Students in Singers, Madrigals, Chorale, and Swing Choir are eligible for the Spring Trip.

Anticipated cost for the trip will be \$150.00.

The Choral Department will be beginning an M2 program for private voice study in the Spring of 2008. The program offers students the opportunity to take individual voice lessons over a 10-week session each semester. The advantages to this program are cost and convenience. The rate for private lessons in Lexington is approx. \$15 per half-hour lesson or more. The M2 program at Lafayette is only \$100 for the 10-week session, and the majority of the private instruction takes place in the practice rooms of the Lafayette music department, under the direction of highly qualified music consultants. Enrollment spots are limited.


From Ms. Gabbard

As November comes to a close, we can reflect several successful SCAPA voice events such as the latest installment of our master class series. On November 15th, Dr. Joyce Wolf (professor of voice at EKU) spoke with our studio about proper performance etiquette and stage presence. Several students helped to demonstrate the correct way to enter and exit the stage during a performance, as well as how to take a bow, acknowledge the accompanist, etc. Dr. Wolf also provided critique of performances by the following students: Emma Jackson, Ryan Story, Micah Miller, Sydney Steele and Douglas Waterbury-Tieman. Congratulations on a job welldone and thank you for being so responsive to Dr. Wolf's advice. We will not have another master class until February due to the end of semester events and various other activities happening in January.

On Friday evening November 16th, prior to the production *All the Way Home*, SCAPA hosted a coffee house/art lease which featured several vocal performers. **Emma Jackson and Andrew Miller** performed a duet. **Katherine Bennett, Wood VanMeter and Alaina Broderson** performed solos. Thank you to these students for volunteering their time to perform!

Finally, just before Thanksgiving break, we held our fall semester vocal juries. This is a time for students to perform pieces they have been preparing all semester for a grade. This year we also used the jury grade to determine participation in the winter recital. All students who earned a 92% or above on the jury will be singing for the recital. Congratulations to everyone for being so well-prepared. Your hard work in private lessons and in class is really paying off!

To wrap up the semester, on Friday, December 7th we will have our **Winter Recital** at the Episcopal Church of St. Michael the Archangel (located on Bellefonte). The recital will begin at 7:00pm.
