Chick Corea's four-decade career is the stuff of jazz lore - his groups are hotbeds of imagination, seething with the joy of making music while creating influential, limit-stretching musical experiences. Of course, the same could be said of fellow Miles Davis alum Jack DeJohnette, and of Bobby McFerrin, one of the natural wonders of the music world whose work encompasses both classical and jazz through vocal performance, conducting, and composition. This sensational trio comes together for the first time for what promises to be an unforgettable night of jazz.

On April 25 and 26 we will travel to Indianapolis, IN to take in a concert of 3 jazz greats at Clowes Memorial Hall on Butler University Campus. We will stay Friday night, participate in a choir clinic on Saturday morning, eat at Circle Center Mall, and have other fun activities in the afternoon. We will return to Lexington on Saturday evening.

Students in Singers, Madrigals, Chorale, and Swing Choir are eligible for the Spring Trip.

Anticipated cost for the trip will be \$150.00.

Our first event of the semester is the Women's Choir Festival on Friday, February 1st. This is a new event which will consist of an all day rehearsal at Singletary Center, followed by a performance in the evening. All SCAPA women are required to participate, along with all members of the women's choir as well as Swing choir ladies. We will also combine with Scott Co. High School and Western Hills High School for part of the performance. We will have 2 after school rehearsals prior to this event since we do not all meet together during the school day. These rehearsals will take place on January 23rd and January 31st from 3:20 until 4:30. Music/information packets are available from Ms. Gabbard.

Other upcoming events include a Master Class on Thursday, February 21st from 3:30-5:00. If you are interested in performing, please see Ms. Gabbard. Attendance is required for Master Classes. Another mandatory event is KMEA Solo & Ensemble Contest. This will take place at Scott County High School on Saturday, February 23rd. Please turn in your registration forms and fees ASAP! All voice majors must perform solos for this event. You may also participate in a small ensemble if you would like.

If for some reason this is not working for you, please let me know and turn in a paper copy of your log instead. These weekly grades may not seem like much at the time, but they do add up by the end of the semester. Remember...practice logs are not accepted past the due date. Katie Berger, senior SCAPA Vocal Music Major, sings and dances at the National Catholic Youth Conference. Selected by audition in May, Katie served as choir member, liturgical dancer and featured soloist at this biennial event held at Nationwide Arena in Columbus, Ohio, November 8 – 10, 2007. After being selected, she attended a three-day intensive training program in Ohio in August where music and choreography were learned by a 42-member choir and dance troupe. She was chosen from this group for the honor of performing the Conference theme song, "Discover the Way," at the general session programming with over 20,000 people in attendance. She was also selected to sing with noted Catholic song-writer and performer, John Angotti, the song, "We Will Be the Light."

Women's Choir Festival

Looking ahead to next semester, we are very excited about a new choral event that will take place in February, 2008. The Lafayette Women's Chorus will host an invitational women's chorus festival at the Singletary Center on Friday, February 1st. This will involve our women's chorus along with ladies from other LHS choirs, the women's chorus from Western Hills High School and the women's choirs from Scott County High School. This large ensemble will rehearse a variety of choral literature with clinician Dr. Sue Ellen Ballard (Director of Choral Activities, EKU) all day on Friday and will then present a concert in the evening. Each choir will sing individually as well as combined. We are looking forward to the start of a new tradition in the advancement of our women's choir program here at Lafayette!



The Kentucky Music Educators Association sponsors district level Solo and Small Ensemble contests across the state. The Lafayette choral department urges all choir students to participate in district 7 (Lexington District) assessment each year. It is extremely valuable for students to participate in solo and ensemble contest. Signups will be due by January 11.
