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# From the Director

Dear Parents and Students:

I am asked regularly to give advice about voice lessons for high school students. I believe that high school age is a good age to begin voice lessons. While adolescent voices are still very early in their development, most having just gone through the voice change, voice lessons are an outstanding opportunity for students to improve their vocal technique as it relates to breathing, posture and other vocal issues. Vocal lessons can also often positively affect confidence and performance ability. While we strive to work as much technique in an ensemble setting as possible, we cannot possibly address all issues the way private instruction can. Just like in band and orchestral programs, vocal programs are positively affected when a higher number of students receive one on one instruction on a regular basis.

I would urge all of our students to think about private vocal coaching/instruction. There are many qualified teachers in the area. Even SCAPA Voice students are urged to seek weekly private lessons outside of their in-school coaching session.

What to look for in a private teacher: Find a teacher who will challenge you. Study with a teacher you like and are comfortable with. Look for a teacher who insists on regular sessions. Find a teacher who encourages and provides opportunities for their students to participate in recitals, competitions and solo-ensemble festival. Expect to pay between \$15-\$25 for a half-hour lesson. The Choral department keeps a list of area voice teachers available to download from our website. www.lafayettechoir.org/voiceteachers.pdf


#### From Ms. Gabbard

These students gave outstanding performances and were provided with feedback and some new ideas about vocal production. This was a truly successful event!
